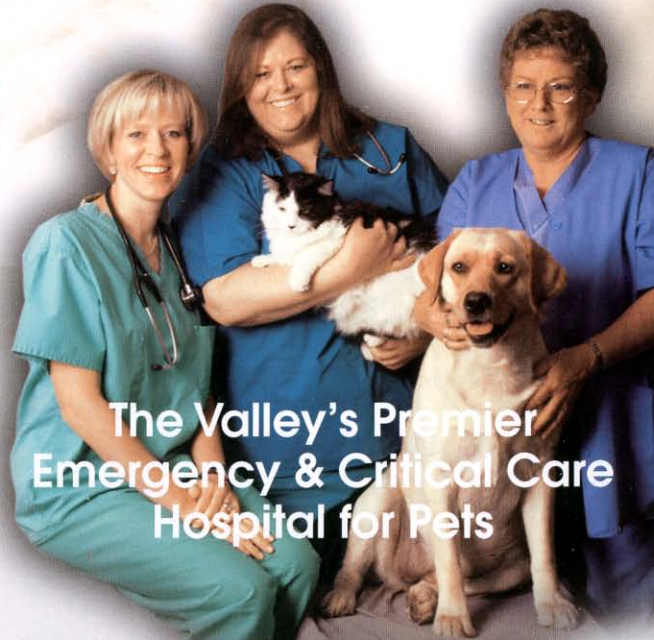

Four clinics are located strategically throughout the Phoenix metropolitan area. They are open 24 hours a day, seven days a week including holidays.

Founded in 1974 by a small group of practicing veterinarians, Emergency Animal Clinic, PLC is currently owned by over 200 local veterinarians who depend upon its services when their offices are closed.

The veterinarians, technicians and support staff of Emergency Animal Clinic, PLC are first and foremost animal lovers themselves. They have extensive training, certification, and experience in emergency and critical care veterinary services, and they care for their animal patients as if the pets were their own. Staff members are gentle with their animal patients, giving words of comfort, loving strokes, and even a few scratches behind the ear.

All of our clinic locations are equipped with sophisticated, state-

of-the-art diagnostic and monitoring equipment that aid us in the diagnosis and treatment of your pet.

When to call and visit us

From difficulty breathing to poisoning, seizures to heatstroke, open wounds to hidden trauma, ...the trained staff of the Emergency Animal Clinic will provide the specialized care necessary to try to save a pet's life. If your pet is injured, or suddenly develops symptoms of a life-threatening disease, proper emergency care should be initiated quickly.

Pets, like children, don't plan to be sick but when they become ill, we understand your concern and worry. Many times this happens during the evenings or weekends when your family's veterinarian is unavailable or office is closed. We are here to help you through those stressful times.

When you enter our doors, our receptionist will greet you and the triage nurse will assess the medical status of your animal. As in human emergency departments, our patients are seen on the basis of medical priority, with the most life-threatening cases first.

Since our clinics are dedicated to providing emergency and critical care veterinary services when your family veterinarian is unavailable, it is important to us and to your pet's doctor that we advise him or her of our course of treatment. We are not a substitute for regular veterinary care and

we encourage all pet owners to establish and develop a relationship with a primary care veterinarian for all of your companion animals.

What you need to do

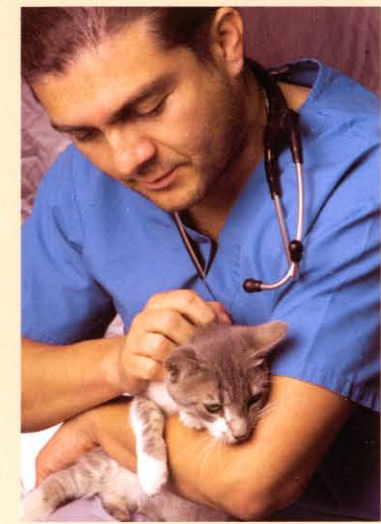
Plan ahead for your pet's emergency medical needs and

Call your family's veterinary clinic, or if the emergency takes place outside of their regular business hours, call Emergency Animal Clinic for help. Identify the problem or symptoms to our staff member who will provide you with further instructions.

How you can be prepared

Pet ownership has its responsibilities. Proper medical care is as important as providing food,



shelter and love. The financial responsibilities to owning a pet also includes being prepared in times of emergencies, just as you are for your own human family members.

Services at Emergency Animal Clinic are based upon the individual needs of each pet. There is

an initial emergency consultation fee that covers the examination of your animal by our highly trained veterinarians. You will be provided with a

written estimate of services needed by your pet, which can include diagnostics, treatments, medications, and overnight in-hospital care.

As is normal business practice, fees are payable upon delivery of the services. Depending upon the extent of the care required, a deposit may be

requested. For your convenience, Emergency Animal Clinic accepts all major credit cards, cash, and personal checks, with proper identification.
